





What can the J & E Coalition Do to Help?????



Under New York City's Right-to-Counsel (RTC) law, DSS/HRA's Office of Civil Justice (OCJ) provides tenants facing eviction in Housing Court or NYCHA administrative proceedings with access to free legal representation and advice provided by nonprofit legal services organizations from across the five bouroughs.

Right-to-Counsel legal services are **free**, available in **every ZIP code**, and available **regardless of immigration status**.

84% of tenants who had a lawyer through the Right to Counsel program avoided eviction.

Facing eviction? Call 311 and ask for "Right to Counsel". You don't have to face eviction alone.

The J & E Coalition – Victim Rights Committee can start this work.
